

M I N U T E S O F M E E T I N G .

The April meeting of the council of the rural municipality of Duck Lake No, 463, was held in the town hall Duck Lake, on Saturday the first day of April. All members present.

Re an account presented by the Standard Trusts Co, for Mr A. H. Bushnell's Hospital expenses, it was moved by Coun Mandin that Sec'y be instructed to request said company to settle this account out of the proceeds of Mr Bushnell's estate. Car.

Moved by Coun Bell that last quarterly instalment of 1915 and first quarterly instalment due schools for 1916 be paid over to the respective school districts. Car.

Dr Mc Ritchie of Duck Lake is re-appointed health officer and A. Baynton of Carlton, Municipal Auditor for year 1916, on a motion by Reeve Craig. Car.

Owing to the ever increasing amount of relief requested throughout this rural municipality it was moved by Coun Blakeney that a maximum amount of \$15.00 be set, per month for one family. Car.

Moved by Coun Blakeney that Sec'y be instructed to correspond with the board of highway commissioners, requesting help to open the meridian line from Macdowall to Lily Plain, as the old trail is being gradually fenced in. Car.

The appropriation for road work comes in the following amounts, viz., Division No, (1) \$900. Division No, (2) \$600. Division (3) \$360. Division (4) \$163. Division (5) 301.60 Division (6) \$376.40.

Couns Lemauviel, Blakeney and Anderson moved respectively the first second and third reading of bylaw re restraining animals from running at large and said bylaw was passed unanimously.

Moved by Coun Blakeney that a rate of four mills in the dollar be levied on all assessable lands for the year 1916, also an additional mill for patriotic purposes. Carried.

Coun Bell was appointed deputy reeve for ensuing quarter on a motion by Coun Pocha. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned on a motion by Coun Anderson. Car.
