

Minutes of August Meeting.

Minutes of regular monthly meeting of the council of the rural municipality of Duck Lake, No. 463 held in Duck Lake, on the 5th day of August 1916, with all members present.

Minutes of last meeting read and adopted, motion by Coun Bell.

The Weeds' Inspector's report for Divisions 3 & 6 was read, considered and adopted without discussion, motion by Reeve Craig, and said report ordered filed for future reference. Car.

Reeve Craig's report re McIvor's claim, next came before the council for consideration; according to said report no more than two acres of land have been expropriated by this council. Therefore coun Blakeney moved that Sec'y be instructed to correspond with Mr McIvor and offer him an amount of \$24.00 for the said two acres. Carried.

The following accounts were passed and ordered paid, viz.,
W. J. Pozer for relief to indigents, \$122.85 - Constant Amiot for relief to Roger Vermette's family \$10. - Rent of Council chambers for town \$44.00 for two years. - Repairs for machinery, \$7.30

The following cancellations were ordered by the council, All taxes to end of year 1915 on N.E. of 5-46-2, All taxes on N.E. of 2-46-3, on the N.W. of 18-46-2, on the N.E. of 2-46-3, on the S.W. of 14-47-3, on the N.E. of 13-44-2, on frac of 23-45-3, on the N.W. of 35-46-1, on the N.E. of 15-46-3, and on the N.E. of 25-46-3 taxes to be cancelled on 120 acres only.

Moved by Coun Blakeney that Sec'y be instructed to correspond with the Hon Minister of the Department of the Interior requesting grant of a road allowance on Sec, 11-47-1, running East and West, on the North half of the section as the present road allowance between sections 11 & 14 is impassable on account of muskegs.

Messrs Mitchel & Courchene, as representatives of the Duck Lake

Agricultural Society, asked for a grant of \$150. for the year 1916 and coun Bell immediately moved that said amount be granted. Car.

The meeting adjourned, motion by Coun Anderson.
