

The regular monthly meeting of the council of Rural Municipality of Duck, Lake, No, 463, was held in Duck Lake, on Saturday, July, 4th, 1914.

All members present at the meeting.

1st

The minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted on a motion of councillor Keenan. Carried.

2nd

Two visitors from Div, No, 6, Messrs S. Blakeney, & A. E. Warren of Lily Plain, also attended the meeting.

A bill from the City Hospital, Saskatoon was laid on the table, and the Sec was instructed to inform the Hospital Authorities that the patient treated was in a position to pay his own bill.

The following bills were ordered paid and passed before the council.

Dr McRitchie, for medical fees, \$10.25. S. T. Willoughby \$36.65 for books and stationery, Road work in Division, No, 2. \$18.75 and Ellis Bros, \$8.00.

Bylaw No 13 re a loan for school purposes, received its first reading on motion of Coun, Gervais.

Moved by Coun Adams that Coun Keenan be authorized to construct a road between Sec 24 - 46 - 1, and across the N.W. corner of Sec, 25 - 46 - 1 instead of between 24 & 25 as previously planned. Carried.

Bylaw No, 13 received its second reading on a motion by Coun, Adams.

Moved by Coun Keenan that Coun Adams be authorized to construct a road between Sec 35 & 36. Township, 47 - 1 - 3 instead of between Sec, 13 & 14 as previously planned. Carried.

Bylaw No, 13 received its third reading and was passed. Carried.

Moved by Coun Keenan that Sec be instructed to forward a resolution to the Stallion Licensing Board to the effect that this council recommends the granting of a Stallion Permit, to Dr Touchette, owner of Standard Bred Stallion, Black Watch. Carried.

Messrs Blakeney and Warren then respectively addresses the meeting re expenditure of Debenture funds, and the meeting was moved adjourned on a motion of Coun Adams. Carried.
