

Minutes of Meeting.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Duck Lake, No. 463, was held in Duck Lake Town Hall Council Chambers, on Saturday, July 3rd, 1915.

All members present. Coun. Cross arrived late owing to inability to cross the river on account of recent flood.

The minutes of previous meeting read and adopted, motion to that effect by Coun. Gervais. Carried.

Moved by Coun. Gervais that road allowance between Sections 28, 29 and 33 be leased to Messrs. J. Vernerez & J. Gagne for a period of five years, for the sum of five dollars. Carried.

Visitors and ratepayers attended the meeting. Call again, you are all welcome.

Representatives from the Duck Lake Agricultural Society attended the meeting, (Messrs. C. H. Kalbfleisch & J. Perillat). They asked the Council to grant the sum of \$200. After some discussion it was moved by Coun. Gervais that the Council grants the sum of \$150. Coun. S. O. Blakeney amended the motion to the effect that \$100. only be granted. The matter was put to a vote and resulted as follows: In favor of first motion, Couns. Gervais, Pocha, Robin, Bell & Reeve Craig. Against, Coun. Blakeney. Motion carried and amount of \$150. granted.

After careful consideration the following cancellations were ordered by the council; motion by Coun. Pocha, viz., on N.W. 27-44-3 - also 21-48-1, on 29-45-3, on N.E. 18-44-1, S.E. of 19, ~~N.W. of 20~~, E. 1/2 of 33, ~~1/2 of 21-46-3~~ all in township 44, Range 1, West of 3rd M., also E. 1/2 of 21-46-3.

The following accounts, presented the council, were examined, passed and ordered paid, viz.,
Geo. Isbister, D.R.O. fee & mileage, \$3.50; The Western Municipal News, for Books & Stationery, \$58.63; C. Klein, \$16.80 for road work; Div. no. 4, for road work, \$85.00. Motion by Reeve Craig. moved that purchase price of road allowance on section 4-49-1 be paid out of general fund. motion by Coun. Blakeney. carried.

Minutes of Meeting.

Moved by Coun. Blakeney that surtax on N.W. of Sec. 10, in Tp. 47, Rge. 1, be cancelled for year 1915. Carried.
Moved by Coun. Pocha that Coun. Gervais be appointed Deputy Reeve for next quarter. Carried.

Moved by Reeve Craig that relief to the extent of \$10.00 be advanced to A. C. McKay, also that all his taxes be cancelled to date. Carried.

Moved by Coun. Bell that second instalment on current school taxes be paid. Carried.

Moved by Coun. Blakeney that all collections on account of 1913 school taxes be paid over to respective school districts. Carried.

Moved that this council adjourns, by Coun. Cross. Carried.
