Month of June meeting of the council of the rural municipality of Duck Lake No, 463 held in Duck Lake Town Hall on the 10th of June all members present also several ratepayers on account of court of revision or appeal against assessment.

Minutes of previous meeting read and adopted, motion by Coun Anderson. The following bills were passed and ordered paid, viz, St Paul's Hospital for treatment to Mrs Harriet Rankin, \$79.50 Relief to W.O. Stevens, \$4.50 Printing, etc, \$12.00

Mr W.H. Coulton of Lily Plain according to Coun Blakeney's report had removed only part of his fence from road allowance, therefore the secretary was instructed to inform Mr Coulton that if he did not immediately remove the balance, that the council would undertake to remove it and get said work done at Mr Coulton's expense.

Coun Blakeney instructed to interview Mr T.J. Agnew re road allowance across the latter's property.

Moved by Reeve Craig that Coun Blakeney be authorized to purchase two acres of land on the S.E. 1/4 of Sec, 3Tp49 R, 1 at \$12.00 per acre. for a right of way. Car.

Moved by Coun Mandin that secretary be instructed to correspond with the Postmaster General re change of mail route between Duck Lake Titanic and Wingard and request to have the mail sent from Duck Lake to Titanic and Wingard as formerly. Car.

Moved by Coun Pocha that arrears of taxes for years 1911 & 12 be cancelled on Chas McKay's land as he entered said land only in 1913. Car  
Couns Pocha & Blakeney presented their report re opening a road in the meridian line and said report was adopted. The secretary was instructed to send a copy to board of highway commissioners. Car.
