The regular monthly meeting of the council of the Rural Municipality of Duck Lake, No. 483 was held in Duck Lake Town Hall Council Chambers on the first day of May, 1915.

The Reeve called the meeting to order at 11 o'clock A.M. and the minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted on a motion of Coun Gervais' Carried.

An application for a grant from the Duck Lake Brass Band was allowed to stand over till next meeting.

Cancellation ordered on the S.W. of 20-44-3, motion by Coun Bell.

Moved by Coun Gervais that first instalment on current school taxes be paid. Carried.

Moved by Reeve Craig that collections of school taxes on account of 1913 arrears, be paid over to the respective school districts. Car.

Moved by Coun Cross that St Jean Baptiste school board be authorized to remove the school house from the present site to the center of the school district. Carried.

Moved by Coun Pocha that sec'y be instructed to forward copy of the following resolution to Hon Walter Scott, also one copy to Right Hon R.L. Borden, to wit., That in the opinion of this council it would be advisable to retain the services of the N.W.M.P in this Province. Car.

Moved by Reeve Craig that J.E. McRitchie, M.D. be appointed Health Officer of this Municipality for one year at same salary as paid on previous year. Car.

Mr Lee of the firm of Stewart Phillips & Lee then addressed the council re the re-survey of townships 43 & 44, Range, 2.

The following bills were passed and ordered paid, viz., Typewriter Co, (Oliver) \$50.00, Assessor, \$75.00 E.L. Christie, \$76.56, Postage, Stationery & Express, \$15.80, Releif, \$4.90 Road Work, Div, (1) 75.70 Machinery, \$9.00,

Motion that above accounts be paid, by Coun Pocha.

Moved by Reeve Craig that rate levied for Municipal purposes in 1915

Moved by Coun Robin that 40 per cent of current Municipal taxes be expended in road work. Car.
